a pop up field guide to a bizarre group of creatures called flanimals showcases their many colorful varieties and their odd behaviors disgusting diets and strange ways of interacting

the flanimals are humorous tubby creatures created by british comedian ricky gervais here they are given what gervais calls a certain poppy upness the amusing text by gervais describing the various flanimals is enhanced by colorful pop ups of the monsters which instead of scaring you make you laugh ages 5 and up

this book situates the picturebook genre within the widespread international phenomenon of crossover literature examining an international corpus of picturebooks including artists books wordless picturebooks and celebrity picturebooks that appeal to readers of all ages focusing on contemporary picturebooks sandra beckett shows that the picturebook has traditionally been seen as a children s genre
