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the posthuman offers both an introduction and major contribution to contemporary debates on the posthuman digital second life genetically modified food advanced prosthetics robotics and reproductive technologies are familiar facets of our globally linked and technologically mediated societies this has blurred the traditional distinction between the human and its others exposing the non naturalistic structure of the human the posthuman starts by exploring the extent to which a post humanist move displaces the traditional humanistic unity of the subject rather than perceiving this situation as a loss of cognitive and moral self mastery braidotti argues that the posthuman helps us make sense of our flexible and multiple identities braidotti then analyzes the escalating effects of post anthropocentric thought which encompass not only other species but also the sustainability of our planet as a whole because contemporary market economies profit from the control and commodification

of all that lives they result in hybridization erasing categorical distinctions between the human and other species seeds plants animals and bacteria these dislocations induced by globalized cultures and economies enable a critique of anthropocentrism but how reliable are they as indicators of a sustainable future the posthuman concludes by considering the implications of these shifts for the institutional practice of the humanities braidotti outlines new forms of cosmopolitan neo humanism that emerge from the spectrum of post colonial and race studies as well as gender analysis and environmentalism the challenge of the posthuman condition consists in seizing the opportunities for new social bonding and community building while pursuing sustainability and empowerment

in a context marked by the virulent return of patriarchal and white supremacist attitudes a new generation of activists from the xenofeminists to pussy riot are continuing the struggle fighting alongside star feminists like emma watson and scarlett johansson these are very feminist times but how do these and other struggles relate to our contemporary posthuman condition in this important new book rosi braidotti examines the implications of the posthuman turn for feminist theory and practice she defines the posthuman turn as a convergence between post humanism on the one hand and post anthropocentrism on the other and she examines the double impact of these two lines of critical enquiry for contemporary feminist practice in so doing she develops five theses that contemporary feminism is neo materialist and that feminism today is not a humanism that anthropos has been de centered and that non human life zoe is now the ruling concept and that as a result of these shifts of perspective today sexuality can be defined as a force beyond beneath and after gender the book ends with a plea for joyful political resistance calling for embedded and embodied cartographies of the new power relations that are emerging from the current geo political order this bold new text by a leading feminist philosopher will be of great interest to students and scholars throughout the humanities and social sciences

the question of what defines the human and of what is human about the humanities have been shaken up by the radical critiques of humanism and the displacement of anthropomorphism that have gained currency in recent years propelled in part by rapid advances in our knowledge of living systems and of their genetic and algorithmic codes coupled with the global expansion of a knowledge intensive capitalism in posthuman knowledge rosi braidotti takes a closer look at the impact of these developments on three major areas the constitution of our subjectivity the general production of knowledge and the practice of the academic humanities drawing on feminist postcolonial and anti racist theory she argues that the human was never a neutral category but one always linked to power and privilege hence we must move beyond the old dualities in which man defined himself beyond the sexualized and racialized others that were excluded from humanity posthuman knowledge as braidotti understands it is not so much an alternative form of knowledge as a critical call a call to build a multi layered and multi directional project that displaces anthropocentrism while pursuing the analysis of the discriminatory and violent aspects of human activity and interaction wherever they occur situated between the exhilaration of scientific and technological advances on the one hand and the threat of climate change devastation on the other the posthuman convergence encourages us to think hard and

creatively about what we are in the process of becoming

if art science and the humanities have shared one thing it was their common engagement with constructions and representations of the human under the pressure of new contemporary concerns however we are experiencing a posthuman condition the combination of new developments such as the neoliberal economics of global capitalism migration technological advances environmental destruction on a mass scale the perpetual war on terror and extensive security systems with a troublesome reiteration of old unresolved problems that mean the concept of the human as we had previously known it has undergone dramatic transformations the posthuman glossary is a volume providing an outline of the critical terms of posthumanity in present day artistic and intellectual work it builds on the broad thematic topics of anthropocene capitalocene eco sophies digital activism algorithmic cultures and security and the inhuman it outlines potential artistic intellectual and activist itineraries of working through the complex reality of the posthuman condition and creates an understanding of the altered meanings of art vis à vis critical present day developments it bridges missing links across disciplines terminologies constituencies and critical communities this original work will unlock the terms of the posthuman for students and researchers alike

the notion of the posthuman continues to both intrigue and confuse not least because of the huge number of ideas theories and figures associated with this term more posthuman glossary provides a way in to the dizzying array of posthuman concepts providing vivid accounts of emerging terms it is much more than a series of definitions however in that it seeks to imagine and predict what new terms might come into being as this exciting field continues to expand a follow up volume to the brilliant interventions of posthuman glossary 2018 this book extends and elaborates on that work particularly focusing on concepts of race indigeneity and new ideas in radical ecology it also includes new and emerging voices within the new humanities and multiple modes of communicating ideas this is an indispensable glossary for those who are exploring what the non human inhuman and posthuman might mean in the 21st century

the devolved and dispersed character of human agency and moral responsibility in the contemporary condition appears linked with the deepening global trauma of inhumanism as a paradox of the anthropocene reclaiming human agency and accountability appears crucial for collective resistance to the unprecedented state of environmental and social collapse resulting from the inhumanity of contemporary capitalist geopolitics and biotechnologies of control understanding the potential for such resistance in the posthuman condition requires urgent new thinking about the nature of human influence in complex interactional systems and about the nature of such systems when conceived in non anthropocentric way through specific readings and uses of deleuze s conceptual apparatus this volume examines the operation of human actioned systems as complex and heterogeneous arenas of affection and accountability this exciting collection extends non humanist concepts for understanding reality agency and interaction in dynamic ecologies of reciprocal determination and influence the outcome is a vital new theorisation of human scope responsibility and potential in the posthuman condition

on the advanced knowledge economy which perpetuates patterns of discrimination and exclusion and the threat of climate change devastation for both human and nonhuman entities robots designed to care for people and neglected landscapes of digital trash the promise of synthetic biology and the panic of living on a dying planet wonderful feats of intelligence and systemic acts of violence exhilaration and exhaustion rosi braidotti argues that we must think about these apparent contradictions all together in order to make differences that actually matter posthuman knowledge and the critical posthumanities oscillates between evocations and transections of contemporary conditions for which braidotti offers what she calls the posthuman convergence as a new paradigm for situating and navigating their problems and possibilities reflecting on the knotted situation of the academic humanities cognitive capitalism and advanced climate change she delivers an intersectional critique of humanism and anthropocentrism and targets their exclusions and aporias to address subjectivity knowledge production and academic structures within that posthuman convergence braidotti's convergence demands imagination endurance connectivity and perspectives multiplied embodied and grounded in the only world we have

the notion of the human is in need of urgent redefinition at a time of radical bio technological developments and in light of the political and environmental imperatives of our age the term posthuman provides an alternative the philosophical landscape which has developed as a response to the crisis of the human includes several movements such as posthumanism transhumanism antihumanism and object oriented ontology this book explains the similarities and differences between these currents and offers a detailed examination of a number of topics that fall under the posthuman umbrella including the anthropocene artificial intelligence and the deconstruction of the human francesca ferrando affords particular focus to philosophical posthumanism defined as a philosophy of mediation which addresses the meaning of humanity not in separation but in relation to technology and ecology the posthuman shift thus emerges in the global call for social change responsible science and multispecies coexistence

uncovering the theoretical and creative interconnections between posthumanism and philosophies of immanence this volume explores the influence of the philosophy of immanence on posthuman theory the varied reworkings of immanence for the nonhuman turn and the new pathways for critical thinking created by the combination of these monumental discourses with the philosophy of gilles deleuze and félix guattari serving as a vibrant node of immanence this volume maps a multiplicity of pathways from deleuze guattari and their theoretical allies including spinoza and nietzsche to posthuman thought as positions that insist respectively on the equal yet distinct powers of mind and body immanence and the urgent need to dismantle human privilege and exceptionality posthumanism each chapter reveals concepts for rethinking established notions of being thought experience and life the authors here take examples from a range of different media including literature and contemporary cinema featuring films such as *enthiran* the robot india 2010 and *chappie* usa mexico 2015 and new developments in technology and theory in doing so they investigate deleuzian and guattarian posthumanism from a variety of political and ethical frameworks and perspectives from afro pessimism to feminist thought disability

studies biopolitics and social justice countering the dualisms of cartesian philosophy and flattening the hierarchies imposed by humanism from deleuze and guattari to posthumanism launches vital interrogations of established knowledge and sparks the critical reflection necessary for life in the posthuman era

life writing in the posthuman anthropocene is a timely collection of insightful contributions that negotiate how the genre of life writing traditionally tied to the human perspective and thus anthropocentric qua definition can provide adequate perspectives for an age of ecological disasters and global climate change the volume's eight chapters illustrate the aptness of life writing and life writing studies to critically reevaluate the role of the human vis à vis non human others while remaining mindful of persisting inequalities between humans regarding who causes and who suffers damage in the anthropocene age the authors in this collection not only expand the toolbox of life writing studies by engaging with critical insights from the fields of posthumanism and ecocriticism but in turn also enrich those fields by offering unique approaches to contemplate the responsibility of humans for as well as their relational existence in the posthuman anthropocene

this book works to delineate some of the major routes by which science and art intersect structured according to the origin myths of the posthuman that continue to shape the idea of the human in our technological modernity this volume gives space to narratives of alter modernity that resonate with ursula k le guin's call for a new kind of story which exposes the violence and exploitation driven by a sustained belief in human exceptionalism anthropocentrism and cultural superiority in this context the posthuman myths of multispecies flourishing given in this collection which are situated across a range of historical times and locations and media and modalities are to be thought of as kernels of possible futures that can only be realized through collective endeavour

problematic assumptions which see humans as special and easily defined as standing apart from animals plants and microbiota both consciously and unconsciously underpin scientific investigation arts practice curation education and research across the social sciences and humanities this is the case particularly in those traditions emerging from european and enlightenment philosophies posthumanism disrupts these traditional humanist outlooks and interrogates their profound shaping of how we see ourselves our place in the world and our role in its protection in posthumanism in practice artists researchers educators and curators set out how they have developed and responded to posthumanist ideas across their work in the arts sciences and humanities and provide examples and insights to support the exploration of posthumanism in how we can think create and live in capturing these ideas posthumanism in practice shows how posthumanist thought can move beyond theory inform action and produce new artefacts effects and methods that are more relevant and more useful for the incoming realities for all life in the 21st century

feminist posthumanism in contemporary science fiction film and media from annihilation to high life and beyond places posthumanism and feminist theory into dialogue with contemporary science fiction film and media this essay collection is intimately invested in the debates around the posthuman and the critical posthumanities within a feminist critical

theoretical framework in this posthumanist light science fiction as a genre allows for new imaginings of human technological relations while it can also be the site of a critique of human exceptionalism and essentialism in this way science fiction affords unique opportunities for the scholarly investigation of the relevance and relative applicability of specific posthumanist themes and questions in a particularly rich and wide ranging popular cultural field of production one of the reasons for this suitability is the genre's historically longstanding relationship with the critical investigation of gender specifically the position and relative empowerment of women the original analyses presented here pay close attention to audiovisual style including game mechanics facilitating the critical interrogation of the issues and questions around posthumanism where typically the mention of sf in the posthumanist context calls to mind a whole set of often clichéd tropes the cyborg technologically augmented bodies ai subjectivities etc this volume's thirteen chapters analyze specific examples of contemporary sf cinema that engage in meaningful ways with the burgeoning field of critical posthumanism and that utilize such films to interrogate posthumanist and feminist as well as humanistic ideas

the volume delves into the provocative terrain of escape as a mode of resistance through a diverse array of studies encompassing political theology and artificial intelligence the author navigates the philosophical landscape of exiting established forms of knowledge and practices drawing from a rich tapestry of western thought from carl schmitt and st augustine to bernard stiegler and antonio negri the volume engages deeply with the notion of forging new pathways beyond existing political paradigms the chapters present a fresh perspective on the dynamics of political transformation urging readers to reconsider conventional boundaries and embrace innovative approaches to social change by examining the intersections of philosophy politics and technology it invites readers to contemplate profound questions about liberation creativity and the potential for radical societal renewal it is an essential reading for scholars activists and anyone intrigued by the philosophical underpinnings of resistance and the quest for new horizons in political theory and practice

this book examines several distinctive literary figurations of posthuman embodiment as they proliferate across a range of internationally acclaimed contemporary novels clones in kazuo ishiguro's *never let me go* animal human hybrids in margaret atwood's *oryx and crake* toxic bodies in indra sinha's *animal's people* and cyborgs in jeanette winterson's *the stone gods* while these works explore the transformational power of the biotech century they also foreground the key role human capital theory has played in framing human belonging as an aspirational category that is always and structurally just out of reach making contemporary subjects never human enough in these novels the dystopian character of human capital theory is linked to fantasies of apocalyptic release as such these novels help expose how two interconnected genres of futurity the dystopian and the apocalyptic work in tandem to propel each other forward so that fears of global disaster become alibis for dystopian control which in turn becomes the predicate for intensifying catastrophes in analyzing these novels justin omar johnston draws attention to the entanglement of bodies in technological environments economic networks and deteriorating ecological settings

it brings together a range of critical approaches the gothic monster theory critical posthumanism post structuralism postcolonialism feminist theory fat studies cyborg theory including very recent forays into posthumanist new materialist intersections it contributes new readings to the critical canon on a wide range of critically acclaimed texts from mary shelley s frankenstein via toni morrison s and angela carter s work to margaret atwood s maddaddam trilogy it explores narrative strategies of resistance against systemic cultural oppression and challenges a number of critical approaches in the process

this volume was first published by inter disciplinary press in 2016 the nature of empathy its potential for healing and harm and its potency to effect change for good or ill at inter personal ecological and global levels are key themes represented in this interdisiciplinary volume section one looks at physiological and philosophical roots of empathy exploring

neurological factors as well as the question of human selfhood in relation to the other the notion of wrong empathy then comes under scrutiny where the potential for empathic responses to upturn moral codes is examined this leads into a focus on the written word with exploration of written text and the act of writing on empathic responses the scope is widened in the final sections to focus on ways to teach empathy and potential global effects of expanded empathic awareness amidst critical challenges facing humanity today it poses the crucial question how can we find more peaceful communion with those whose differences we fear

this book brings together the emerging insights of what posthumanism new materialism and affect theory mean for the man question the contributors to this book interrogate the question of how man as a gendered being is entangled with nature culture materiality and corporeality and they explore ways to unsettle men s sense of sovereignty to decentre anthropocentric masculinity men have to move from the centre of privilege which grants them supremacy before they can open themselves to the decentred embodied affective vulnerable and relational self that is necessary to embrace the posthuman this book explores the extent to which this is possible the book will be of interest to academics students and scholars across a range of disciplines who are engaging with the intersections of feminist studies with posthumanism and new materialism especially as they relate to critical studies of men and masculinities chapters on fathering pornography ageing affect embodiment entanglements with technology and nature and the implications of these issues for changing men and masculinities and the politics of critical masculinity studies engagement with posthuman feminisms will interest students and academics across these diverse disciplines

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
